The World Veterinary Orthopaedic Congress: "Synergy in Action"

Syn-er-gy (noun) -

the interaction of two elements that when combined produce a total effect that is greater than the sum of the individual elements; the working together of two things to produce a result greater than the sum of their individual effects.*

Synergy describes what occurs when two professional veterinary societies from different continents join together to organize an orthopaedic congress for veterinarians from around the world. Next year, on March 1-8, 2014 we will see that synergy in action once again during the 4th World Veterinary Orthopaedic Congress (WVOC). From its inception, the World Veterinary Orthopaedic Congress has embodied the definition and spirit of synergysynergy created from combining ideas, surgical techniques and cutting edge research from experts around the world in small animal, equine and human orthopaedics.

History of WVOC

The WVOC has a rich history founded in a spirit of collaboration. Prof. Geoff Sumner-Smith, the patron and Founding Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Veterinary and Comparative Orthopaedics and Traumatology, VCOT, was the first to bring the idea of a World Orthopaedic Congress to two veterinary orthopaedic societies – the European Society of Veterinary Orthopaedics and Traumatology (ESVOT) and the Veterinary Orthopedic Society (VOS). The Boards of Directors of VOS and ESVOT enthusiastically adopted his concept and formed the first World Veterinary Orthopaedic Congress planning committee.

To promote international collaboration, ESVOT and VOS agreed to host the event

every 4 years on alternating continents. The inaugural WVOC was held in Munich, Germany in 2002. The high standard of the scientific programme, the internationally renowned speakers and the wonderful culture and beauty of Munich set the bar very high for all future meetings...and the tradition has continued.

The 2nd WVOC was held at Keystone, Colorado, USA in 2006 in combination with the 33rd Annual VOS Meeting. Once again, the Congress was a huge success, thanks to the combined efforts of the ESVOT and VOS WVOC planning committee and the excellent scientific programme. In keeping with the VOS tradition, time for skiing riding was built into the schedule and the spring snow brought a large amount of fresh powder for everyone to enjoy. The 3rd WVOC was held in Bologna, Italy in 2010. Congress attendees enjoyed an exciting cutting-edge scientific programme, small animal and large animal wet labs, unforgettable social events, food and culture. It was the most well-attended WVOC to date and increased the visibility of the WVOC world-wide.

The VOS/ESVOT synergy continues with the 4th WVOC, scheduled for March 1-8, 2014 at the Beaver Run Resort and Conference Center in Breckenridge, Colorado, USA.
